




## WAGON WHEEL


Wagons with hidden compartments were one of the primary means of transporting escaping runaways. The quilt was a message to pack provisions for their journey as if they were packing a wagon and pack only supplies essential for survival.



Chose 6 different 1930's fabrics, your choice for wagon wheel spokes ,plus 1 for the center.


1-12 1/2" square of white fabric for background.

Cut 2 spokes **from** 6 1930's fabrics, for a total of 12 spokes using template E



*Spoke Wedge*

Cut 1 small circle **from** the 7<sup>th</sup> using template H



Sew together alternating fabrics to make a circle. Press seams in one direction. Cover the center with the small circle.

Press the background in fourths. Center the circle On the background. Pin in place and applique down, by machine or by hand.
