

Bear's Paw

Bear Claws


Cut 8 background squares 2-518 x 2-5/8. Cut 8 dark brown squares 2-518 x 2-518. To make 16 triangle squares $2 - \frac{1}{4} \times 2 - \frac{1}{4}$

Layer the dark brown with a background square Mark a line from comer to comer on background square sew 1/4" on each side.

Cut apart on center line, press open to dark.

Or

Use any other method you want to make the triangle squares



Bear's Paw

Cut 4- 4" squares **from** lighter brown **Dividing strips**

Cut 4 rectangles 2" x 5 314 from dark green.

Center square

Cut one 2" square from blue fabric

For comers, from the background cut 4 squares 2 1/4 x 2 1/4

PIECE TOGETHER FOLLOWING THE **GRID** ON THE FRONT PAGE.

Should measure 12 1/2" square.
