CROSSROADS TO JERICHO From the book SCRAP **QUILTS**

MAKING THE BLOCK 8 ¹/₂ x8 ¹/₂ finished

White muslin4 different light floral fabric.

From white muslin cut $5-2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares From each light floral cut $1-2\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

From each light floral fabric, cut 1 -5 1/8" square. Cut the square **from** comer to comer **making** 2 triangles. Set one of each of the triangles to the side for another block.


MAKING THE CENTER 9 PATCH


For the 1st and 3rd strip of your nine patch, <u>sew 1 muslin,1 floral,1 muslin</u> together. For the center strip <u>sew 1 floral,1</u> <u>muslin. 1 floral</u> together. Sew the 3 strips together, making sure the floral squares are on the out side of

your nine patch.


Sew the triangles to each side matching the colors.

Trim to 9" square.
