Have you ever used lime green as a neutral? Other background possibilities - white tone on tone/black / white print make brights pop. This quilt looks great in red, white and blue.
Or USE ANY FABRICS YOU HAVE TO TRY IT OUT

Have you ever worked with bright fabrics or always wanted to but haven't found the right pattern. Then you will love this easy and fun class. We will be making these non-traditional Evening Star blocks by using a strip pieced paper piecing method. Great for beginners who would like to try a new method of paper piecing and for those of you who just love paper piecing. The paper foundations are included in your pattern fee. During class we will make at least 3 blocks, but you may want to cut for more than just 3 blocks

Pattern fee: \$4 for paper piecing patterns already printed -enough for quilt.

Fabric requirements for entire quilt

1 1/8 yards of 3 different lime green fabrics for background or your choice of fabric for background

1 1/8 yards of black stripe fabric for sashing strips

1/4 yard of black solid for cornerstone squares

An assortment of brights (fat quarters work great)

3/4 yard of deep pink tone on tone for inner border

1 1/2 yards of multi colored print fabric for outer border

1 yard for binding

Supplies for class

Basic sewing supplies

Sewing machine with open toed foot and/or 1/4" sewing foot

Rotary cutter (45mm and 28mm) /mat

Paper scissors

Long ruler (if you plan on cutting fabric in class), 9 1/2" square ruler

Basic paper piecing supplies ie: Add-A-Quarter 6" ruler, wooden presser

Remember these cutting instructions are only for three blocks. If you would like to cut more or cut for the entire quilt, please feel free to do so. BRING ALL OF YOUR STAR AND BACKGROUND FABRICS TO CLASS

Before coming to class, please cut the following:

From each background fabric, cut: 4 squares - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2",

4 squares - 4 1/4" x 4 1/4"

From 3 different bright prints, cut: 1 square - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2",

1 strip - 6" x 22"
