

**Theresa Morrison** still needs items for the Blue Bonnet Store. She reported the aprons were good sellers last year.


**Sue Ryan** needs donations for the kitchen. She sent a sign up sheet around for water, paper goods, Crock Pot Soups, and sandwiches.


