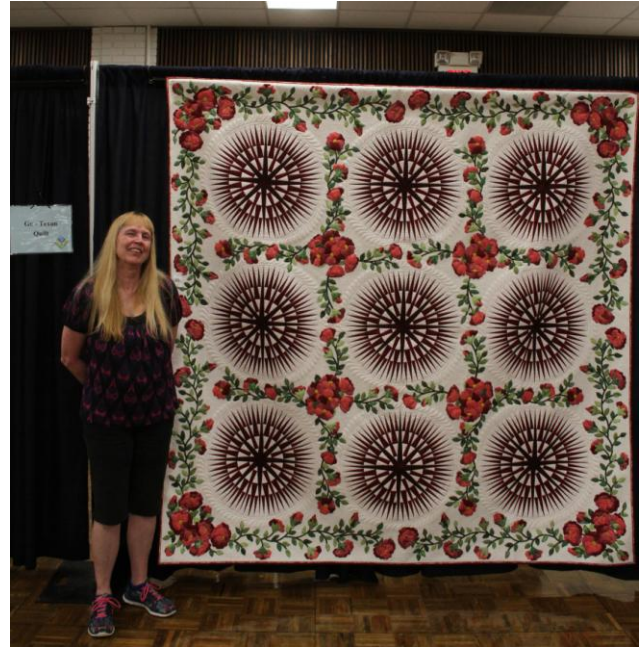

Class will encompass all aspects of invisible machine appliqué including template and pattern piece preparation, tips for laying out perfectly placed designs, and instruction for using your sewing machine to achieve finished appliqués that truly look hand stitched. 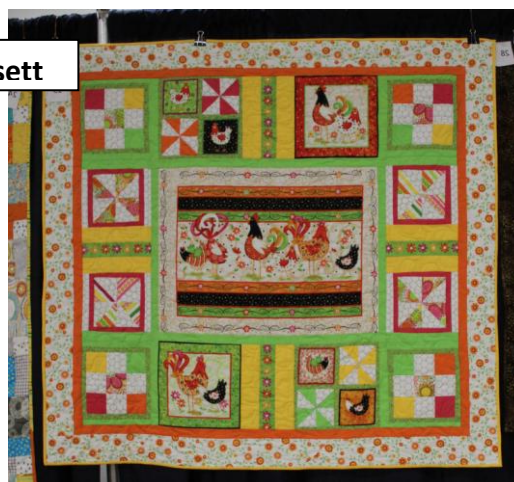
