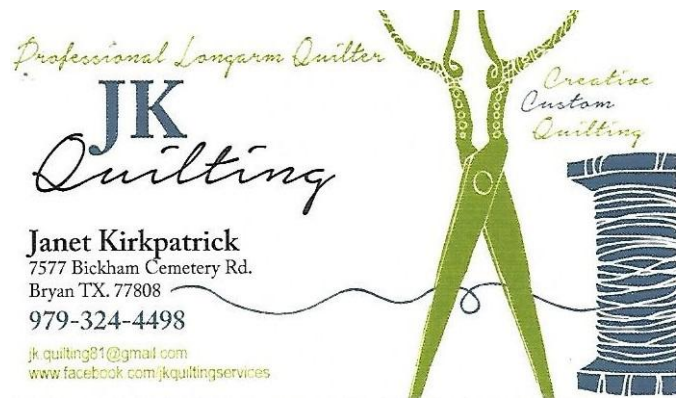

Please include a note with the name to be on written on the ticket(s), and a contact phone number. We will fill out the tickets for you, and put them in the drawing.

Tickets are \$1.00 each, or 6 tickets for \$5.00, so a great value for \$5.00, and the drawing is September 15th!

If you prefer to fill out your own tickets, let us know, and we will mail them to you. (You will need to mail them back completed with your check by Sept. 15th.)

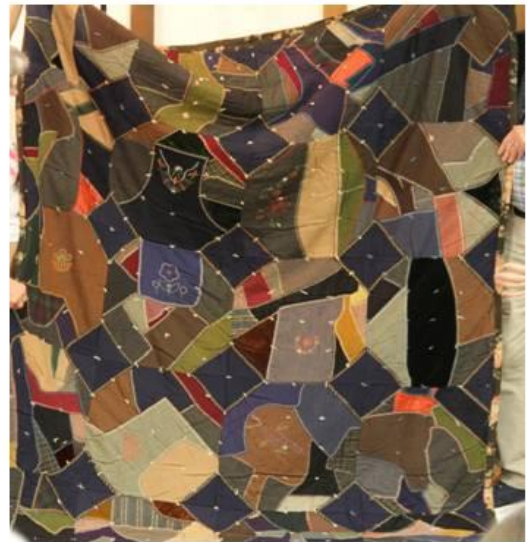
