

Brazos Bluebonnet Quilt Guild Scholarship Application Form

This scholarship is funded by the Brazos Bluebonnet Quilt Guild, a local group that promotes the appreciation of quilts and quiltmaking. The guild awards this scholarship to pursue higher education in the visual arts, family and life sciences, career tech, or a related field at accredited college or technical school.

The scholarship is for one year only in the amount of \$1000, paid as \$500 per semester directly to the college. At least two awards will be given to applicants from the pool of graduating high school seniors in the Bryan/College Station high schools including private schools and home schooled students. Each scholarship winner will also receive a handmade lap quilt.

Award recipients are required to mail in a short form providing college address and contact information, within 30 days of the start of classes at their chosen college before funds are disbursed.

Application consists of:

- **The completed attached form**
- **A transcript which includes grade point average and class rank**
- **Teacher recommendations and/or letters**
- **Photographs or copies of artwork, or directions to a website displaying artwork or performance (photographs and artwork will not be returned). Family or life science projects (e.g. 4-H projects) should be summarized on a separate page.**

Selection is based equally on:

- **Intended major in college**
- **Grades, course difficulty, and class rank**
- **Family financial need, based on parents' employment and size of family**
- **Quality of artwork**
- **Letters of recommendation**
- **Community service activities**
