<b>Thursday Feb 9</b>	<b>Color Theory</b>	<b>10a-1p</b>	<b>All Levels \$35</b>	<b>Jimmie H</b>	Why study color theory? If you are involved in the creation or design of visual documents, an understanding of color will help when incorporating it into your own design. We will discuss basic color theory and why some colors work together and some do not. If you have a project you would like to make but aren't sure about choosing colors bring it to class. You will leave class with your own color wheel and a better understanding of color.
